**Notes:**

1. The maximum number of people on the mine visit is 30.
2. Delegates should be physically able to do some moderate walking, and assume all risk of injury, loss or damage; personal protective equipment will be provided by Cummins
3. Please send a copy of the completed registration form to [christelle.moncion@canada.ca](mailto:christelle.moncion@canada.ca) by September 6, 2019 and preference will be given to those attending the conference. The field trip registration fee of \$350 per person includes all above transportation, lunch and dinner on October 6 and lunch and dinner on October 7.
4. It is suggested that delegates stay at DOUBLETREE BY HILTON JAMESTOWN in order to leave early the next morning by bus to the mine site. Delegates are responsible to make their own hotel reservation at (716) 488-7227, by cut-off date of September 16<sup>th</sup>, 2019, and must specify "MDEC CUMMINS" to access the negotiated rate of (US\$119 per room, (breakfast included, applicable taxes additional).
5. **IMPORTANT: Passports** - A valid passport book is required for international travel and for entering the United States by ground transportation. A valid passport book or other compliant document is required for domestic travel and we strongly recommend that all persons travel with a valid passport, even when not required. Caution: The requirements described are government regulations and policies. They are subject to change without notice. It is the sole responsibility of the guest to identify and obtain all required travel documents and have them available when necessary. These appropriate valid travel documents, such as passport, visas, inoculation certificate and legal documents, are required for entry into the United States. Passport book expiration date should not occur within six (6) months of the expected date of crossing into the US.
